

EXPLORE THE WILD SIDE OF ICEL AND

When visitors dive deeper into Iceland, they find so much more than they intended or expected. It is one of the few destinations in the world that has a little bit of everything. But many only see Reykjavík and its outer environs. While these iconic sites are worthy destinations which we will call on, the real heart of the country is in its remote landscapes, vast interior, and hard-to-reach coastal gems where we center our explorations. There are exhilarating discoveries to be made in this remarkable region: stunningly beautiful landscapes from brilliant green hillsides to stark, imposing mountains; geological marvels like bubbling mudpots and explosive geysers; incredible birdlife; ancient history; modern-day culture; and fascinating locals who can trace their lineage back to the settlement of their country. LOCAL LUMINARIES

Each Iceland expedition features opportunities to meet and hear from interesting locals aboard ship, including:

SILJA ÓMARSDÓTTIR

Professor of International Affairs. Focused on Icelandic society and politics, reproductive rights, Iceland's foreign and security policy, and feminist international relations. Served as chair of Iceland's Gender Equality Council and on the Constitutional Council of 2011.

THÓRA ARNÓRSDÓTTIR

Investigative journalist, documentary film producer, candidate for Icelandic president in 2012. Lecturer at University of Iceland on International Relations and holds degrees in Philosophy and International Economics & Development.

RAGNA ÁRNADÓTTIR

First woman to hold the position of Secretary General of Althingi, the Icelandic Parliament; former CEO Iceland's National Power Company that produces 75% of the country's electricity.





ARCTIC CIRCLE

Go ashore at Grímsey, home to nesting sea birds, and enjoy a celebratory toast on the Arctic Circle.

BERGEN

Bergen is at once modern and medieval, and the Hanseatic League's influence is still evident in its colorful wooden clapboard wharf. Tour the waterfront, the Maritime Museum, and dine atop Fløyen Mountain with panoramic views.

Explore the volcanic Lake Mývatn region.
